**Preliminary Minutes**

1. Medical Imaging Renovations/Construction Update - M. Wilson
  - 1.1. Melanie reported on the status of the IR lab and the sedation area. The IR lab floor and ceiling modifications are almost complete. The room should be ready to turnover to the vendor soon. Some modifications to the original sedation area design have been requested by anesthesiology. The requests have been implemented. A load bearing column in the sedation area was discovered and modifications to allow removing the column have caused a 3-week delay in the schedule.
  
2. Teleradiology - J. Ey
  - 2.1. John reviewed the attached handout showing average monthly vRad turnaround times (TAT) since March 2017. February month-to-date average TAT is 35 minutes, continuing a worsening three-month trend. Of concern is the percentage of studies which exceed 1-hour TAT (second page of attachment). DPI has been in touch with vRad regarding the long-range outlook and receives weekly forecasts of “challenging” nights. DPI is investigating other teleradiology companies, but few have the number of pediatric radiologists that vRad has available. Despite the recent challenges, the departmental changes implemented with the third shift techs (i.e., working closely with ED to assess priority, staying in contact with vRad operations center) seem to be satisfying the ED and providing the level of patient experience and safety necessary.
  
3. Sean Kelleher, M.D. - J. Ey
  - 3.1. Dr. Sean Kelleher will join DPI and DCH in July after completing his fellowship at Nationwide Children’s in Columbus. The privileging process is underway. April mentioned that the PC and monitors for his home have been ordered. A CV (attached) was distributed. Sean has requested to have the standing monitor desk currently in use in 2W 279 be moved to his new home when it is no longer needed.
  
4. Fuji PACS - A. Madden
  - 4.1. Dr. Warren has distributed a schedule for DPI physicians to meet with the Fuji PACS representatives during this week. This is the final vendor to visit and a decision/recommendation on PACS vendor is expected soon. A discussion regarding DCH “enterprise” decisions

followed. It appears that the DCH decision and budgetary process (likely in fiscal year 2021/22) will delay the final implementation of the recommended Medical Imaging PACS system.

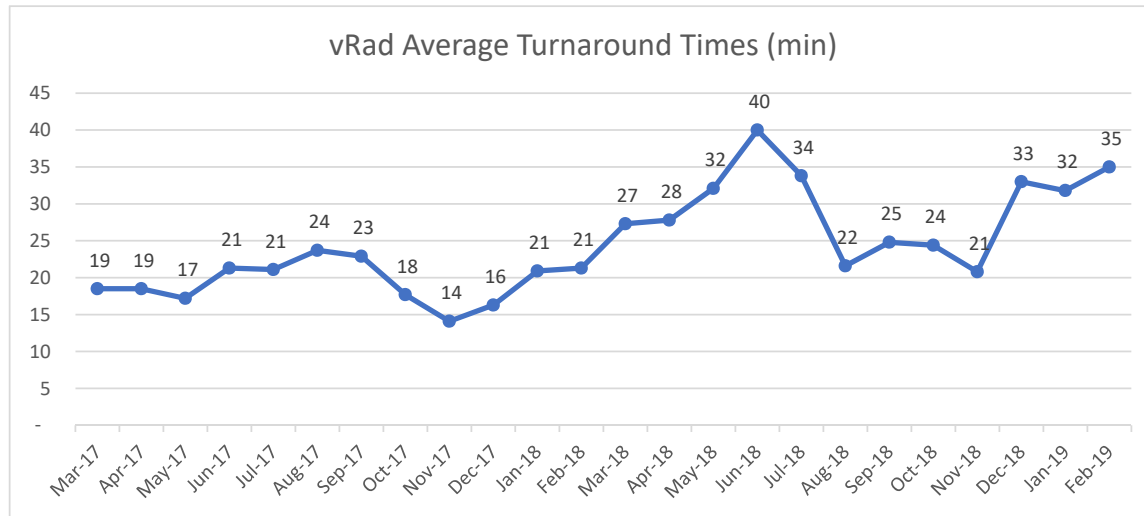
5. Other

- 5.1. Dr. Roebel reviewed a possible new Medical Imaging technologist position called a “fluoroscopy coordinator”. This proposal is an extension of the previously discussed idea for a radiology assistant or physician extender. As currently conceived, the two interventional coordinators, Sara Fults and Emily Cromer, who are currently rotating in an “on and off week” rotation could cover the fluoroscopy coordinator position on their IR off weeks. Some questions to be explored include:
  - 5.1.1. Would the job description be within the scope of practice for the technologist?
  - 5.1.2. What is the impact on the speech pathologist?
  - 5.1.3. What is the proposed number of personnel “in the room” under the proposed arrangement?
  - 5.1.4. Melanie indicated that she will continue to research this option.
- 5.2. Keith Jones and April Madden discussed Dr. Ey’s question regarding difficulty in finding the volume of Cystoconray used during VCUg in the reports. It is possible that either training and or a change in data input will be necessary. Keith agreed to follow up on this.
- 5.3. John Ey mentioned that DPI is recruiting for one additional radiologist, placing ads in three radiology webpages.

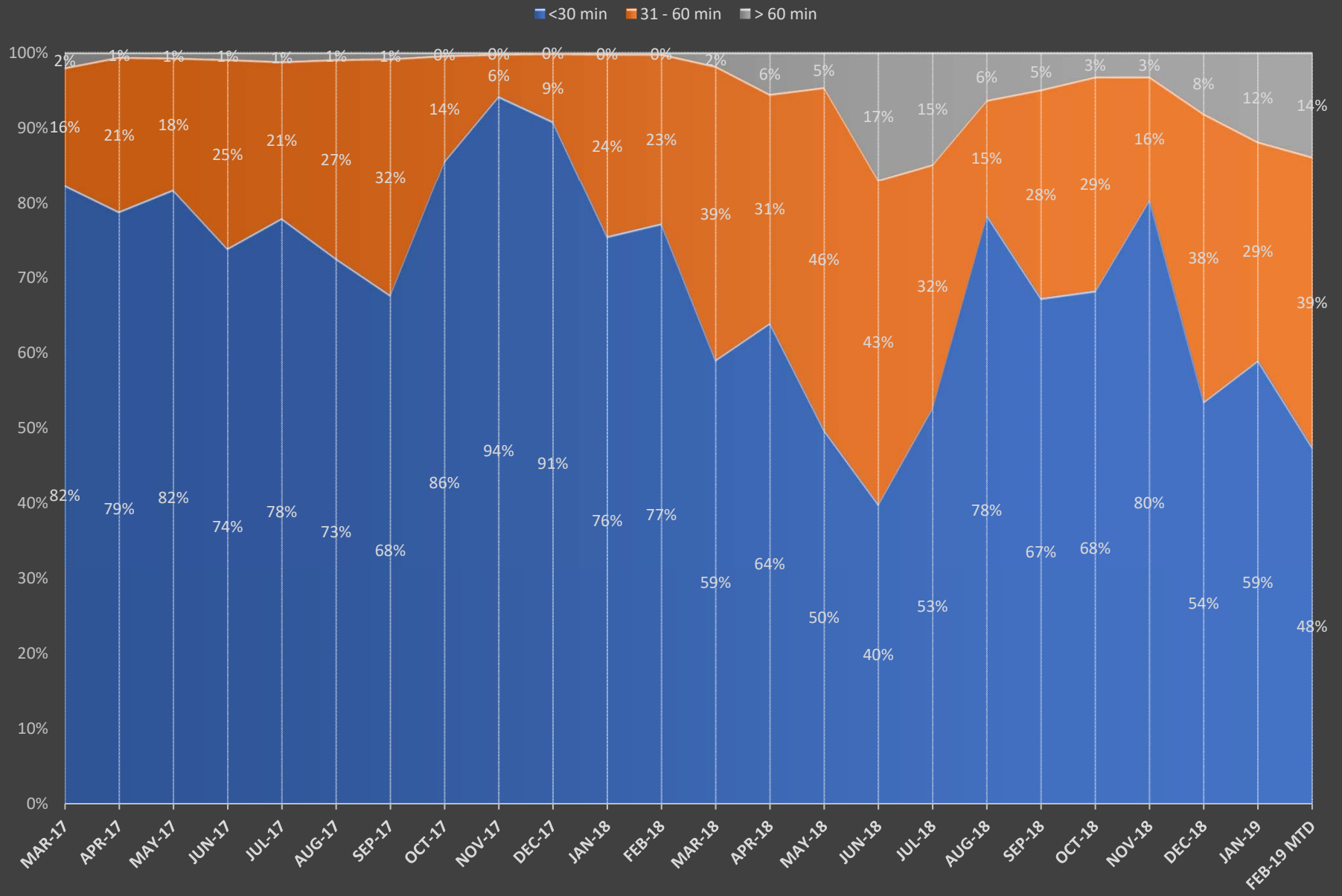
